### NOTES

**All helmsmen must possess a valid measurement certificate and insurance whilst sailing with the club.**

All racing will be conducted under the current R.Y.A. Racing Rules of Sailing & HPYC Sailing Instructions. The latter taking any precedence. See [www.hpyc.org.uk/](http://www.hpyc.org.uk/)

Where more than 1 race is scheduled on the same day, the time of the subsequent race will be announced on the day.

**Adequate personal buoyancy must be worn whilst participating in all club events and safety boat duties.**

Wearing of wet or dry suits is strongly recommended in cold or inclement weather during the season.

All boats must carry anchor, warp and paddles as per the H.P.Y.C. Sailing Instructions. Failure to do so in any race will result in disqualification.

Handicap racing will be in accordance with R.Y.A. Portsmouth Yardstick Scheme unless otherwise specified.

Average lap timing may be used in some cases, details of which are on the notice board and in the Sailing Instructions.

Classes for Series racing to be determined by the Sailing Committee and announced prior to commencement of the Series.

### DUTIES OF HELMSMEN AND CREWS

**All helmsmen and crews who participate in racing, general Sailing or training Sessions will be called upon during the season as Race Officers, Assistant Race Officers, Safety Boat Skippers, or Safety Boat Crews. Please report on duty 90 minutes before published start time.**

A Rota of all duties will be drawn up, published and operated by the Rear Commodore via Duty Man.

It is the responsibility of the members concerned to update Duty Man and to advise the Rear Commodore at the earliest opportunity if they are unable to carry out their duties so that The Rear Commodore may arrange a suitable replacement.

Where a duty is carried out 3 points will be awarded in the results. Note, a maximum of 3 points per helm will be counted in any one series. **Where there are 2 short back-to-back series races (A/B) 3 Points will be awarded per race.**

In the event of a member not being present for a duty, the names of qualified members present will be drawn for that duty.
